AIRFIELD WORK

- Airfield work, including Runway and Taxiway restrictions, will be decided on a case-by-case basis and must be requested at a
 minimum, 1 week prior to the start of the moratorium through the project's Aviation Design and Construction Project Manager
 and the Airside Operations Supervisor Construction Liaison
- The FAA may issue a Maintenance Moratorium NO access to FAA manholes or duct banks will be allowed during the specified moratorium
